- (1) Tarleton State University acknowledges that they have signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement. Tarleton State University has or will be using the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
- (2) Tarleton State University has been allocated, received or will receive from the Department of Education for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs is \$20,392,209.00 (ARP = \$14,945,449 and CRRSAA = \$5,446,760)
- (3) The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs is \$16,267,157.
- (4) The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs is ~18,000.
- (5) The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs is 6090.
- (6) The method used by Tarleton State University to determine which students received Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs is based on the completion of an application and evaluation of need based on the students Estimated Family Contribution (EFC).
