

TUITION AND PAYMENTS

First-time Texas resident undergraduate students have two payment options for tuition and fee plans when entering Tarleton State University. Students must choose between a guaranteed (fixed) tuition and fee rate plan for the first four years of attendance at Tarleton, or a variable plan that will increase annually.

At the time of first time registration, a selection box will appear for option selection. Choose the preferred option, confirm acceptance of financial notices, and then move on to registration. When making your selection, an explanatory document on the Guaranteed Tuition Plan is available for review. Although plans may be changed after registration, the last day to change options is in early August, when financial aid is disbursed.

Rate Plans

Guaranteed Rate Plan

These rates are fixed for the duration of a student's four-year term. After the four-year term, the student rates will change and increase to the rate of the current variable plan.

- Based on a fixed charge that is provided whenever a Texas resident undergraduate student registers for the first time.
- Not offered for non-resident students or graduate or doctoral students.
- Location-specific fees are not covered by these plans and are subject to change with Board of Regents approval.

Variable Rate Plan

These rates are subject to change on an annual basis in accordance to the Higher Education Price Index (HEPI) and other Board Approved tuition rate changes. However, costs may vary based on actual enrolled course and degree program chosen.

- Location-specific fees are not covered by these plans and are subject to change with Board of Regents approval
- Most attractive for those students who plan to attend for two terms or less, and do not plan to attend for the full four-year graduation cycle
- Factors that may cause the rate increase to be higher than the initial HEPI change include Board approved tuition rate changes or changes to other fees charged by the university

Due Date and Payment Options

Tuition, fees, room and board payments are due in full on **Thursday, August 12, 2021**. If you are unable to make payment in full by this date, there are payment plan options available. We offer one payment plan that consist of 4 equal payment throughout the semester. Payment plan due dates are listed below. All students are required to either make payment in full or enroll in a payment plan and make payments on designated due dates.

When will I see a bill or statement?

Billing statements will be posted online in Texan Bill Pay by the end of July. An email notification will be sent to each student notifying them of the availability of the statement.

Texan Bill Pay

Texan Bill Pay allows students to view account statements and pay tuition and fee bills for Tarleton State University online. As statements are generated, email notices are sent to the student's official university email account prior to the start of the semester. Tarleton State University does not mail paper bills or statements for tuition and fees.

All tuition, fees, housing, and meal plan expenses are billed through Texan Bill Pay. All financial aid (grants, loans, and scholarships) are also billed through Texan Bill Pay. Students can log in and view a detailed bill showing all expenses and financial aid. If expenses are more than financial aid, students will be billed for the amount. If the financial aid is more than the expenses, students will be issued a refund.

Texan Bill Pay Includes

- Important payment deadlines
- Detailed account information for every term for which you were registered at Tarleton
- Account balances and payments made for each term for which you were registered at Tarleton
- Tuition and fee schedule/billing statements
- Online payment plan enrollment
- Schedule future payments

Payments accepted include VISA, MasterCard, Discover, American Express, Electronic Check and Debit Card. Beginning July 15, 2018, payments made by credit card will be assessed a 2.85% service fee. To pay by eCheck, you will need to provide a US Bank checking account number and routing number. There is not a service fee associated with payments made by eCheck (ACH). Both methods are simple and secure.

Authorized Users

Students may set up notifications to be sent to alternate email addresses or to provide access to authorized users (parents, spouses, etc.). Authorized Users enter through an alternate secure website that provides access to view and pay eBills.

Your email address is your login ID. An email will then be sent to your email address with your login password.

You may select more than one Authorized User to access your student account. An Authorized User can be deleted by the student, by selecting "Delete" under action.

Payment Plans

Students must enroll in the payment plan via Texan Bill Pay. A \$20.00 processing fee will be added to the students account upon enrollment.
