Organizational History

The Texan News Service (TNS) is a unit in the College of Liberal and Fine Arts' Department of Communication Studies at Tarleton State University in Stephenville, Texas. The unit operates as a learning-laboratory for students wishing to pursue careers in journalism and broadcasting. Student publications produced by the TNS include *The Grassburr*, the university's yearbook, and *The J-TAC*, the student newspaper. Students may gain broadcasting experience through the KTRL 90.5 FM radio station and Texan TV News. The radio station provides music, news, talk, local programming, and Tarleton sports to the community. It also airs popular National Public Radio (NPR) programs. Texan TV News airs one hour a week on Northland Channel 9, Apogee Channel 2.1, and Facebook Live.

Tarleton State University was established in Stephenville, Texas on September 4, 1899. Through the years it has been known by several names: John Tarleton College, John Tarleton Agricultural College, Tarleton State College, and Tarleton State University. The institution joined the Texas A&M University System in 1917. It is a four-year college with almost 100 undergraduate and graduate degrees. The Fall 2021 academic enrollment was over 14,000.
